# SPRING GLORY®

### APPEALING HABIT

This North American native is simply unbeatable when it comes to four season beauty. Spring Glory<sup>®</sup> kicks off the growing season with delicate white flowers – because they emerge before the foliage, they have considerable impact. As summer comes on, the neat oval foliage hosts an abundant crop of sweet fruit, relished by humans and birds. Fall foliage is an outstanding orange-red, and winter allows its strong, single-trunk form to shine. Ideal as a street tree, specimen, or for natural/native plant gardens and restoration projects.

#### RUGGED

History shows that landscapers, designers, and homeowners can't resist the allure of a white bark birch. Bark starts out tan, takes on pink tones and then turns that bright, stunning white. Neat emerald green leaves develop golden fall color. ## LUSCIOUS LAVENDER<sup>™</sup>


### SUPER SHOWY

All beauty, no distraction: this beautiful redbud has more of what everyone loves about this native tree and nothing they don't. Spring brings thousands of electric purple flowers held closely to the grey branches. The thick, glossy, heart-shaped leaves that follow are showier than most, since this nearly-fruitless selection develops few seedpods to distract from the display. Useful size and shape make it a versatile option for residential and commercial landscapes.

## CAVALCADE OF COLOR

Pagoda dogwood is noted for its distinctive strongly horizontal branching which makes a memorable statement in the landscape. Golden Shadows<sup>®</sup> dogwood makes that habit even more dramatic with its colorful yellow and green variegated foliage. It often emerges with shades of red and orange, accompanied in spring by a host of lacy white flowers. At its best when planted in light, filtered shade where it adds brightness, structure, and color.

### VERSATILE HABIT

Finally, a compact kousa dogwood! This useful variety is as floriferous, longblooming, durable, and beautiful as its conventional counterparts but just half the size. The large white flowers are long lasting and develop into showy red fruits. Fall brings vivid red foliage. Can be grown as a small tree on its own roots or used as a top graft for a unique presentation sure to appeal to homeowners looking for something very showy for small spaces.

## THORNLESS

It's hard to believe that a tree that's so undeniably pretty in spring can also be so tough, but that's Crusader<sup>®</sup> hawthorn. Despite its abundant white floral display in late spring, attractive silver bark, colorful fall foliage, and showy fruit, this thornless native hawthorn tolerates just about any challenge you can give it. It shrugs off wet and dry soils, is not fussy about pH levels, is unbothered by clay or salt, and resists the many diseases that often plague the rose family, so it's the perfect choice for difficult urban areas, parking lots, street plantings, and more.

### SHOW-STOPPING COLOR

When spring comes, it's show time for all crabapples, but this one really grabs the spotlight. The large, densely-clustered fuchsia-red flowers turn the branches into columns of lush color. Deep green foliage has red tones of its own, especially as it emerges. In fall, red fruits glisten among the bright orange and red leaves. Oval, upright habit lends a touch of formality as a specimen or street tree. Recommended as a replacement for 'Prairifire' by Ohio State University.
