

Make a Butterfly Feeder

Materials



STEP I: GLUE POT TO SAUCER

Apply glue to the bottom of the terracotta pot, then press the center of the saucer down onto the glued area. Let the glue set to attach the pot and saucer.

STEP 2: PAINT BASE COAT

Once the pot and saucer are securely glued, paint them a bright base color like yellow, orange, or red.

STEP 3: DECORATE IT!



STEP 4: PLACE THE FEEDER IN THE GARDEN

Place the butterfly feeder in your garden, nearby flowers if you can. Add sugar water, fruit, or both, to the saucer to attract butterflies.

- Drop Cloth
